Johns Hopkins Children's Center

Founded in 1912 as the children's hospital of the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions, The Johns Hopkins Children's Center offers one of the most comprehensive pediatric medical programs in the country, from performing emergency trauma surgery, to finding causes of and treatments for childhood cancers, to delivering a child's good bill of health. With recognized Centers of Excellence in 20 pediatric sub-specialties including cardiology, transplant, psychiatric illnesses and genetic disorders, Children's Center physicians, nurses and staff provide compassionate care to more than 90,000 children each year.

Consistently ranked as one of the top three children's hospitals in the nation by *U.S. News and World Report*, Pediatrician-in-Chief and Given Professor of Pediatrics George J. Dover, M.D., believes the Children's Center's role is to advance pediatric medicine through the translation of novel research into state-of-the-art patient care and training of young physicians, resulting in a synergistic bench-to-bedside approach to medicine.

Centers of Excellence

Heart disease, cancer, genetic disorders, low birth weight and other problems of prematurity, cystic fibrosis, trauma, psychiatric illness, ear, nose and throat problems, infectious disease, Transplants and other surgical procedures with emphasis on pain management, sickle cell anemia and other blood diseases, sleep and breathing disorders, digestive difficulties, seizures and other brain and central nervous system disorders, orthopedic problems, skin conditions, urinary tract disorders, kidney disease, allergies and asthma.

Emergency Services

The Children's Center is part of the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services. Management of multi-system illness and trauma is provided through the Pediatric Emergency Department and the 16-bed Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU), which is staffed by pediatric surgeons, pediatric anesthesiologists and critical care medicine specialists. In 1997 it was designated the official state facility for pediatric trauma care. The Pediatric Emergency Department manages the unexpected medical needs of children through age 18. The service is staffed around the clock and handles nearly 30,000 cases per year.

In addition to treating children who arrive at our doors, staff from the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit and the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit travel by ambulance or helicopter to community hospitals to stabilize and transport infants and children to Hopkins, where they can receive a higher degree of specialized care.
